Grade Four Supply List For September 2011

The following is a list of suggested supplies that students in Grade Four will need starting.

12 scribblers— <u>Pupils should have two (2) spare scribblers on hand at all times—NO COIL SCRIBBLERS PLEASE</u>	1—Spelling Notepad
	1 box of Kleenex
Good quality scissors	200 sheets looseleaf
Pencil Case	1 Pkg. Pencils—should have 2 spares at all times—NO PENS
2 White Erasers	Colored pencils, crayons or markers
2 Glue sticks	1 one-inch binder for looseleaf
Indoor footwear to be worn in classroom—i.e. gym sneakers	Music Dictation Book (Has the name Music on Cover of Book)
1 Ruler	Scrapbook— Coil if possible
Flat Paint Brush— Size 8, 10 or 12	4 Duotang folders
Scrapbook—Coil if possible	3 Scribblers (different than homeroom)
Old Shirt for Art	To be left in box at school— put name on it please

The preferred attire for gym consists of a comfortable tee shirt, shorts that have a stretch waist and clean footwear (cross trainers are the best choice).

Long gym pants should be made of a stretch material so that the legs and waist have some “give”. Nylon pants and tearaways are designed for warm up and aren’t good choices for Physical Education. Jeans are not acceptable for Phys. Ed.

Lunch Money should be put in a wallet or envelope in your child’s school bag. The child’s name should be on the wallet or envelope stating what the money is for.
