Supply List—Grade Primary 2011-2012

The following is a list of suggested supplies that students in Grade Primary will need starting in September, as prepared by next year's Grade Primary Teachers.

#	Item
4	Hilroy Type Scribblers
1	Hilroy Exercise Book—Green cover/72 pages (1/2 plain, 1/2 ruled Product Code is 12155
1 pkg of 8 ONLY Boxes of large quantities are too awkward and confusing	Large Jumbo Crayons are recommended because they are easier to hold onto (Better for fine motor control)
2	White Erasers
4	Pencils—Send in more as needed (Please do not send until needed)
1-2	Glue Sticks—more will be required throughout the year
1	Bottle of White Glue
1	2-Litre Ice-cream container (for storing supplies)— Instead of a pencil case
1	Fairly Good Size School Bag —Make sure it is one that your child can manage. If it has difficult fasteners, then opt for another brand.
1	Lunch Box (Print Student's name on it)
1 Pr.	Indoor sneakers (Gym sneakers) <u>VELCRO CLOSURES ONLY !!!!!!!!!!!!!!! PLEASE!!!</u>
1 pr.	Sturdy scissors (rounded ends) Plastic blades are NOT recommended —since they make cutting <u>Very</u> difficult and will frustrate your child
1	Scrapbook—preferably coil
1-2	Flat #10 paint brush or bigger (Available at 5 to \$1 store, Canadian Tire, Home Hardware, etc.)
Please <u>label</u> <u>all items</u> <u>before</u> your child brings them to school.	

Primary students are requested to leave **all school supplies in the classroom at school**. Supplies will need to be replaced from time to time as the year progresses. Please check with your child.

Lunch money should always be in a pouch, wallet or envelope with the student's name on it.

Also, it helps if you always include a note to explain what the money is for—i.e. what you want your child to buy for lunch.

First Day of School for students is TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 6th

It is strongly suggested that an extra set of clothing is stored in their school bag for “emergencies”.
